



POOL RULES

1. Swimmers use the swimming pool and the facilities at their own risk. Please follow the pool rules and the safety notices in all areas of the swimming pool.
2. You must shower without swimwear and wash thoroughly before entering the pool.
3. Taking pictures or videos is strictly prohibited. Anyone violating these rules will be banned from the premises. Any photographs or video footage must be deleted in the presence of a staff member. Pool attendants may make exceptions, e.g. in case of children's birthday parties, competitions or similar events.
4. Glass containers, musical instruments and recorders or music players are prohibited in the changing rooms, toilets, pool area, outdoors and in or around the sauna.
5. Swimmers may only use the pool when wearing suitable swimwear (this does not apply to the sauna). For swimmers of any gender (m/f/other), this means swimming trunks or speedos, a 2-part bikini, a bathing suit or a burkini.
6. Smoking is prohibited throughout the building and is only permitted outside the building in designated areas.
7. The following persons shall be refused entry: persons under the influence of intoxicating substances, persons with animals, and persons suffering from a notifiable communicable disease (as defined by the Federal Act on Epidemics). In case of doubt, a doctor's certificate may be requested.
8. Non-swimmers please note: the pool is 1.35 meters deep at the shallow end. Non-swimmers who are minors shall only be admitted when accompanied by their parents or legal guardians. Non-swimmers can borrow swimming aids – please ask the lifeguards on duty. In all cases, use of the pool is only permitted for children under 7 years when accompanied by an adult.
9. Warning: artificial current! When the light by the fun pool is on, the strong artificial current is also on. Running, swimming, diving or jumping into the artificial current against the direction of the current is prohibited.
10. Be careful in the diving pool: diving is at your own risk. Bouncing on the diving board is not permitted. The lifeguards on duty will decide when diving boards are available for use. This is essential to ensure that the diving area is clear and that only one person uses the board at a time. When a diving board is available, jumping in from the side, pushing or throwing other swimmers into the pool or swimming in the diving area are prohibited.
11. The use of swimming aids, flippers, diving goggles or snorkels requires special permission. Wearing swimming goggles or contact lenses is at your own risk.

Otherwise, the General Terms and Conditions shall apply.
